1. Mr. Kanade seeks extension of time to file a rejoinder. In the

meantime it is noticed that some of the other respondents who have been

granted time to file reply have still not complied with order dated 9<sup>th</sup> April,

2021. Accordingly, time will have to be extended.

2. Mr. Singh appearing for respondent nos. 14 and 15 who had

undertaken to file vakalatnama has not yet filed his vakalatnama. Today he

states that vakalatnma will be filed without fail on or before 5<sup>th</sup> May, 2021.

He also undertakes to file affidavit of respondent nos. 14 and 15 wherein he

in support of his contentions today states that respondent nos. 14 and 15 have

not received possession of the flats in question, that payments have not been

made and he wishes to make this statement on oath. Let such affidavit also be

filed by 5<sup>th</sup> May, 2021. Accordingly, I pass the following order:

(i) Vakalatnama and affidavit on behalf of respondent nos. 14 and 15 to

be filed in the registry on or before 5<sup>th</sup> May, 2021.

(ii) In the meantime respondent nos. 14 and 15 shall not take any further

steps pursuant to documents at Exhibit G and H. Respondent nos. 14 and 15

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are restrained from dealing with, disposing or in any manner alienating in the event they contend contrary to what is stated by Mr. Singh today.

- (iii) The Co-operative Housing Society housing the said two flats being Flat no. 3, First Floor, Building No. 1, Boat Club Garden Co-operative Housing Society and Flat no. 02, Hermes Complex Co-operative Housing Society Ltd. along with car parking space shall ensure compliance with this order and not issue any certificate or transfer any shares of the ongoing shareholders.
- (iv) The Secretary and Chairman of the Society shall be provided with copies of this order by the Custodian's Advocate and by the petitioners at the earliest and by all possible means. Affidavit of service shall be filed within four weeks from today.
- (v) Mr. Kanade to file rejoinder to the liquidators affidavit by 5<sup>th</sup> May, 2021. Time to file affidavits on behalf other respondents is extended upto 7<sup>th</sup> May, 2021. Likewise time to file and serve rejoinders is extended upto 7<sup>th</sup> May, 2021. Registry to accept replies and rejoinders as aforesaid.
- (vi) Copies of the replies and rejoinders shall be served on other respondents if not already served on or before 7<sup>th</sup> May, 2021.
- (vii) Stand over to 7<sup>th</sup> May, 2021 for compliance of Mr. Singh's client.
