1. Mr. Daruwala states that as far as the 16 judgment debtors forming part of this report are concerned the companies were all subjected to

liquidation proceedings. Responses received from the Official Liquidators

attached to the Bombay High Court, Karnataka High Court, Madras High

Court and High Court of Punjab and Haryana reveal that as presently

advised no amounts are recoverable for the various reasons set out in

responses from the office of the Official Liquidator attached to those High

Courts.

- 2. As far as Madras High Court is concerned all the three companies were facing liquidation proceeding. A communication has been received by the Custodian's Advocate on behalf of one Triveni Travels Limited, Chengalpattu, Tamil Nadu stating that Madras Motors was ordered to be wound up on 26<sup>th</sup> November, 20001. Thereafter a scheme for revival and reconstruction in respect of 23 companies was sanctioned including Madras Motors. The company was dissolved without order of winding up.
- 3. Mr. Daruwalla seeks time to ascertain relationship between Triveni Travels Limited and Madras Motors since Triveni Travels Limited appears to have contended that although they are not liable for the claim as barred by limitation,
